Kurt and Chloe's advocacy led the Pennsylvania Legislature to overwhelmingly pass the Down syndrome Prenatal Education Act ("Chloe's Law") in July 2014, and Chloe signed the law on Governor Tom Corbett's desk.

Guest Speakers

KAREN CROSS, NRLC political director, has devoted 37 years to the pro-life movement. The story of her two abortions has been featured on the 700 Club, in USA Today and various radio and TV programs and newspaper articles. She has spoken nationally, and internationally at a conference



in Poland. She served as executive director for West Virginians for Life for 20 years. In 2005, Ms. Cross was hired as political director for National Right to Life. She is a past president of West Virginians for Life, and currently serves as political liaison for WVFL.
